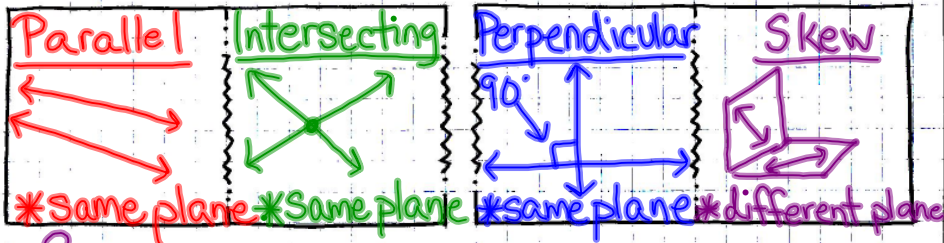
Term	Definition	Picture

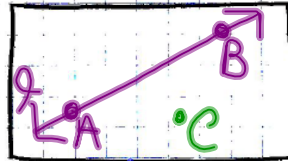
Points, LINES, & PLANES

HOW do Lines interact? They can be...



* 2 points make a line.

* 3 non-collinear points make a plane.

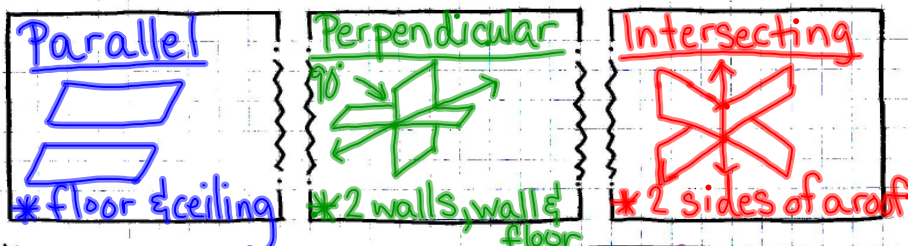


* Lines intersect at exactly 1 point.

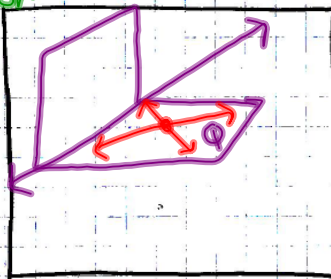
TOC 9 Points, Lines, and Planes

HOW do PLANES interact? They can be...



* 2 or more planes intersect at a line.

* If 2 lines intersect then they are coplanar.



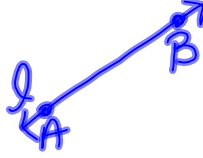

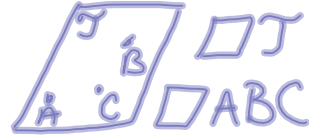
